There are more than 20 million asthmatics in the U.S. In 2000, 12 million people reported having an asthma attack that required urgent care. This resulted in 10.4 million physician office visits, 1.8 million emergency department visits, 465,000 hospital admissions (average LOS of 3 days), and more than 5,000 deaths. Asthma-related healthcare costs are estimated at \$14 billion per year. The prevalence and mortality of the disease are on the rise, current treatments are limited, and there is no known cure.
